But there's nothing tawdry about the **FROZEN ICED TEA** created by Stefan and Albert Trummer, the Austrian-born bar chefs behind the drinks at Town, Kittichai, and the soon-to-open Upstairs at Bouley. "Iced tea is always the same," Stefan says, "but why not make it something really different and special?" At first glance, the frothed tea resembles ... a beer. But its flavor—a subtly sweet combination of tea, passion fruit, and mint—offers a refreshing twist on a summertime staple.

FOR EACH SERVING, COMBINE IN A BLENDER ¼ CUP CHILLED MINT TEA, 2½ OUNCES PASSION FRUIT NECTAR, 1 OUNCE SIMPLE SYRUP, 5 FRESH MINT LEAVES, AND 1 CUP CRUSHED ICE.



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
