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OPENING HOME BOYS

The North Fork is all about the wine, of course, but for brothers Albert and Stephan Trummer, that doesn't mean there isn't room for swank cocktails. The two, who for better or worse helped popularize the term *bar chef* with their creative shaking and muddling at Town, Bouley Bakery, and Citarella, have opened **Home**, a marvelously mellow two-story outdoor lounge with a beachy Amalfi Coast vibe, located clandestinely behind a Victorian house that serves as a real-estate office by day. "We call it a quiet hot spot," says Albert. So far, that's especially true on slow weeknights, when the local thirst for \$12 watermelon martinis and honeydew cocktails, plus panini and cheese plates, has been limited. But on weekends, with Manhattanites en route to Shelter Island and Home's 3 a.m. closing time in effect, things pick up nicely in a quaintly un-souney, anti-Hampton way.
